Hello to All Amputee Golfers:

The Organizing Committee of the **2010 Canadian Amputee National Open (CANO)** wishes to extend a warm invitation to our friends in the amputee golfing community to join us in Edmonton, Alberta, Canada from **August 16 – 19th, 2010**.

For those who are unfamiliar with our city, Edmonton is centrally located in the Western Canadian Province of Alberta. It has been regarded as Canada's Festival City and the tournament will be taking place during one of our most popular – the Edmonton Fringe Festival. If you wish to extend your visit and see more of Alberta, we are three and a half hours from Jasper National Park to the west, four hours from Banff National Park to the southwest, and three hours from Calgary to the south. That's just a short drive for we Albertans and the highways are excellent.

The host course will be the Broadmoor Golf Course which is located in the heart of our neighbouring community, Sherwood Park to the east at 2100 Oak Street. Broadmoor will present you with an excellent layout which is both challenging and amputee-friendly; it is just over 6,000 yards, with the men playing from the **Blue tees** and the women from the **Red Tees**.

Our host hotel for this event will be the **Radisson Hotel Edmonton South** (4440 Gateway Boulevard., Edmonton, Alberta T6G 5C2) located just north of the intersection of the two main roadways of Gateway Boulevard and Whitemud Drive. The Radisson is one of Edmonton's most popular conference hotels and boasts that their newly renovated rooms are among the largest and most tastefully appointed in the City. It is about a 10 minute drive to the Whyte Avenue District where the Fringe will be raging; about 20 minutes to the world-famous West Edmonton Mall; and approximately 20 - 25 minutes to the Broadmoor Golf Course.

The Radisson Edmonton South was chosen for its facilities, convenient access and relatively central location to the various points of interest that you may want to visit. It also offers free parking. We have made a block reservation of rooms that will be offered at \$119 per night, plus applicable taxes of 10%. Please make your reservation as soon as possible and mention that you are guests of the **Canadian Amputee National Open** golf tournament. Edmonton is serviced by the Edmonton International Airport www.flyeia.com which accommodates all the major Canadian airlines and many of the larger American carriers. The hotel is 10 minutes north of the airport on Highway 2, which becomes Gateway Boulevard. As soon as you cross Whitemud Drive, you make a left turn into the parking lot of the hotel. Going back to the airport is just as easy, going south on Calgary Trail.

Broadmoor Golf Course www.broadmoorgolfcourse.com, (780) 467-7373, will be reserving a block of practice round tee times on Monday August 16th. Please email, or phone the course after April 1, 2010 to make a tee time. The cost is \$60 including range balls and half a cart. Remember, when booking, to be on time for the Opening Reception and Players Meeting to be back at the hotel at 6.30 p.m.
